



## MARTINHAL CHIADO – A LUXURY FAMILY CITY BREAK IN LISBON



A day in your short-break at Martinhal Lisbon Chiado Family Suites.

Start with a relaxing Breakfast at **M Bar** Martinhal Chiado or in your room.

Then explore Chiado, the trendy neighbourhood and its surroundings! Visit the famous **Brasileira Café** or **Santini Ice Creams**. Walk through the historic Largo de Camões with most of Lisbon's famous poets and writers hanging out in one square! Go up the **Santa Justa Lift** - one of the city's best-loved landmarks and also known as the "Elevator of Carmo," this extraordinary structure was built in 1901 by the Portuguese-born French architect Raoul de Mesnier du Ponsard (an apprentice of Gustav Eiffel, explaining the structure's similarities to the ironwork in Paris' Eiffel Tower), to connect the lowest and highest points of the city – Rossio square to the Bairro Alto district. Originally powered by steam, it is 45 meters (147ft) high, and remains an interesting example of post-Eiffel iron architecture. The top of the Neo-Gothic tower, reached via a spiral staircase, has a cafe with splendid views of the city, including over Rossio Square, the castle and the river.



Walk down Rua Augusta and then through the **Augusta Arch** onto **Praça do Comercio** – the famous square at the Tejo River which housed all activities regulating customs and port activities in Lisbon for centuries.

For lunch, head to the Time Out Market - an old market turned-into a modern gourmet food court where Portugal's top chefs are represented.

After lunch, if the kids are tired, let them have fun with our Kids Club Staff while you visit the **Ancient Art Museum** or enjoy a shopping afternoon at Chiado, Avenida da Liberdade or El Corte Inglés.

Hop on the seven hills **Tram** to get a general overview of Lisbon's old town – a great 2 hour tour with a multilingual audio guide. You can hop on and hop off as much as you want. We recommend a stop at Portas Del Sol Belvedere for the best Lisbon Views, Estrela Garden and Church. Alternatively, you can try the famous **Tram 28** or explore the city **tuk-tuk**.

Back at the hotel, ask our concierge for restaurant recommendations or check-out our Room Service Menu. If you wish to have dinner in one of the **famous restaurants** in Lisbon, like Bairro do Avillez or Sea Me, please note that reservations might have to be made weeks in advance.

Fancy a drink after dinner? Our Kids club is open until 22:00 (booking required) and the Pink Street, just down the road offers trendy bars and vibrant night life.

There are so many other things to do in **Belém**, the **Parque das Nações** area. Or go to the **zoo**, the **LX factory** or up the statue of Jesus on the other side of the river. Ideas abound. Simply make the time to explore Lisbon as a family and come and stay with us in Martinhal Chiado!
